Sufficient potable water shall be provided daily except as might otherwise be required to provide adequate veterinary care. All watering receptacles shall be sanitized when dirty: Provided, however, That such receptacles shall be sanitized at least once every 2 weeks.

\*\*\*\*\*

One rabbit water bottle has a small amount of algae scum on the interior surfaces. The bottles need to be cleaned often enough to prevent the algae buildup. Besides cleaning the water bottles, receptacles shall be sanitized at least once every 2 weeks or be sanitized when dirty. This is necessary for the health and well being of the animals.
